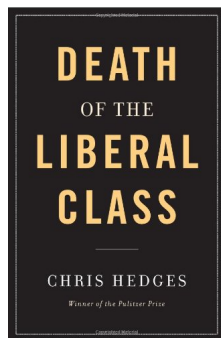

For decades the liberal class was a defense against the worst excesses of power.
