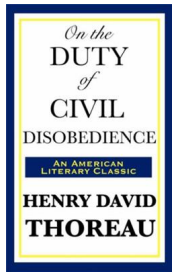

Thoreau wrote this classic essay to advocate public resistance to the laws and acts of government that he considered unjust. The practical application of *Civil Disobedience* was largely ignored until the twentieth century when, at different times, Mohandas Gandhi, Martin Luther King, Jr. and anti-Vietnam War activists applied Thoreau's principles.
